



K-9 Float Coat

There is increasing popularity of water treadmills or just the use of swimming as an integral part of canine rehabilitation. A necessary safety precaution should be the use of a quality life preserver. Most of the standard retail preservers just cannot do the job like the Float Coat.

The Float Coat has a durable nylon shell with an ergonomic fit. The coat is highly buoyant with a low profile assistance handle. This handle can lift the patient safely from the water. Web Master Harness

The safe use of hydrotherapy should include either a float coat or, for advanced swimmers, a safety harness. No patient should be swimming with just a single collar. The Web master Harness has a three point system with a 'D' ring. The lifting handle is low profile with a quick release snap. the harness is made of heavy-duty nylon material for durability.

A secure but comfortable harness designed especially for hydrotherapy.
